Coastal Impacts

The entire Angus Coast has experienced significant impacts as a result of storms during the last six months. East Haven Together is working closely with the Scottish Government Coastal Adaptation Team, Angus Council, NatureScot and the Angus Climate Hub. This is to ensure that as a community we undertake the right interventions to conserve and protect the dunes and coastal environment. The best advice at the moment is to keep measuring the dunes, remove invasive Rosa Rugosa and plant native grasses. We are grateful for funding from the Royal Bank of Scotland regeneration fund and the Co-op to enable this to happen. Two significant studies/research are going to take place during this coming year which will help to guide and inform further interventions in East Haven. We will keep you informed.

FLOODING AND NETWORK RAIL

East Haven Together continues to work with all stakeholders to try and and resolve flooding problems. Network Rail say they may have to leave their assets and pipe in place until nearer the end of the year. The railway line will have to close for the sink hole to be fully repaired. EHT has applied for a Resilience Grant to commission survey work and obtain independent advice.

GLASS RECYCLING

Angus Council plans to change the way we recycle glass has been delayed until the summer. Large glass recycling bins are being placed in all communities across Angus. EHT has worked closely with Angus Council to obtain the best solution for East Haven. The bin can't be placed in the beach car park. After consultation with residents we have negotiated a smaller, discreet bin which will be partly hidden from public view and placed near the green bin next to Dicks garage. It will be quite attractive and the area around it will be landscaped and improved.
